Columbia River Constructors a JV (CRC), a joint venture between Kiewit, Guy F. Atkinson Construction, and Traylor Bros., Inc. is preparing to respond to the Request for Qualifications for the Columbia River Bridge Replacement Project, led by the Washington Department of Transportation (WSDOT), in collaboration with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT).

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Columbia River Bridge Replacement Project is a major component of the Interstate Bridge Replacement (IBR) Program, replacing the existing I-5 bridges between Portland, Oregon, and Vancouver, Washington with two new multi-modal crossings.

The project includes upgraded highway connections, reconstructed interchanges, enhanced local roadway networks, a shared-use bicycle and pedestrian path, and accommodations for future light rail transit. Construction will be phased to maintain traffic flow, incorporate a modern tolling system, and remove the existing bridge structures.
